Sir,

In response to your letter Nos. and subject captioned above, I am directed to state that in terms of Section 3 (f) of the West Bengal S.C. & S.T. (Reservation of Vacancies in Services & posts) Act, 1976, any employment in single post cadre (a cadre which has the strength of one post only) does not come under the purview of the aforesaid Act.

Since the enclosure to the G.O. submitted by the college authority and declaration by the Teacher-in-Charge, shows the sanctioned strength of Electrician-cum-Caretaker, Library Clerk and Library peon as one (1), therefore no authentication needs to be done at present. In case of Clerk(LD), Guard and peon the Register of Appointment for each cadre is needed to be maintained in case of change of character of cadre from single cadre to multi-cadre in terms of Memorandum No.1823-BCW dated 03.06.2009.

**Roster in cases of change of character of cadre from single
cadre to multi-cadre**

MEMORANDUM

It has been observed from references received by this Department that a lot of confusion is arising in setting up roster points in the preparation of Register of Appointments by the establishments, at the time when a single- post cadre is becoming a multi-post cadre by virtue of increase in the number of posts in the said cadre thereby bringing the cadre so long outside the purview of reservation norms subjected to the provisions of the West Bengal Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Reservation of Vacancy in Services and Posts) Act, 1976.

After careful consideration of all aspects it has been decided that the vacancy sanctioned by the Finance Department which changes the character of the cadre from single post to multi-post shall be deemed to be set up at the 1st roster point in the concerned Register of Appointments even if the 1st post of the cadre was sanctioned after 27-03-1990, in the matter of maintenance of Register of Appointments under the West Bengal Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Reservation of Vacancy in Services and Posts) Act, 1976 amended subsequently and the rules framed there under.

This order shall take immediate effect and shall remain valid until further order

All establishments under sub-section (c) of Section 2 of the West Bengal Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Reservation of Vacancy in Services and Posts) Act, 1976 shall act accordingly.

No. 2113-L.— 31st August, 2005.—The following Act of the West Bengal Legislature, having been assented to by the Governor, is hereby published for general information :—

West Bengal Act XXI of 2005

**THE WEST BENGAL SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES
(RESERVATION OF VACANCIES IN SERVICES AND POSTS)
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 2005.**

[Passed by the West Bengal Legislature.]

[Assent of the Governor was first published in the *Kolkata Gazette, Extraordinary*, of the 31st August, 2005.]

*An Act to amend the West Bengal Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes
(Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Act, 1976.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Act, 1976, for the purposes and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Fifty-sixth Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

Short title and
commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the West Bengal Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) (Amendment) Act, 2005.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 2 of the West Bengal Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Act, 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act),—

(1) after clause (a), the following clause shall be inserted:—

‘(aa) “cadre” means the strength of a service or a part of a service sanctioned as a separate unit;’;

(2) after clause (e), the following clause shall be inserted:—

‘(f) “single post cadre” means a cadre which has the strength of one post only.’

Amendment of
section 3.

3. In section 3 of the principal Act, after clause (e), the following clause shall be inserted:—

“(f) any employment in single post cadre.”
